

Revelation 4
September 15 | Group Guide

Begin group time by catching up, praying, reading Scripture, watching a video, and discussing together (20 minutes).

- Begin your group time sharing your highs and lows from the past week.
- Next, spend time in prayer. Ask for the Lord to help each of you take his word into your life.
- Now, read Revelation 4:1-11.
- After reading, watch the Week 5 <u>life group introductory video</u> on Revelation.
- Once the video is finished, have each person describe a time when they were confronted with the grandeur of God's presence. What happened? How did they respond? How did that experience shape them?

Break into smaller groups of 3-4 for discussion (30 minutes).

• What stood out to you or resonated with you most from Dan's sermon on Revelation 4? What stands out to you or resonates with you most from this text? Explain.

- In his sermon, Dan mentioned how worship elevates and captivates us. When was a time you were captivated by God? How has a grander vision of God on his throne challenged or deepened your faith in the past?
- In his sermon, Dan also mentioned how worship aligns us to and humbles us before God. Are there areas of your life where you might be out of alignment? Are there any areas that you need humility in? Explain.
- In Revelation 4, God is worshiped simply because he is "creator." Do you think of yourself as being created? As having a Creator? How would a deeper awareness of this knowledge shape how you live today? How might this bring about humility?
- Where is worship lacking in your life today? How can this group help you cultivate a life of deeper worship?

## Come back together as a large group and then split into triads for prayer requests and prayer (10 minutes).

Like last week, split your group into mixed triads as you wrap up. In each triad, have people share their prayer requests. Once everyone has finished sharing, each person should then pray for the person on their right until everyone in the triad group is prayed for.

## Finish with logistics (5 minutes).
