



Revelation Week 4
September 8 | Weekly Devotionals

OPEN with prayer.

Begin this devotional exercise by finding a quiet place where you can spend time with God in his word. Before reading, pray that the Holy Spirit would open your eyes and heart to what God wants to say to you.

READ Revelation 2:18-3:21.

- What are the four churches John addresses in these verses?
- List out all the ways Jesus gives *comfort* and *encouragement* to these churches.
- List out all of the ways Jesus gives *challenge* to these churches.

- What are the promises that Jesus gives to each church if they “conquer” or are “victorious?”

REFLECT

- Like last week, if you were to have a sit down conversation with Jesus today, which of the above encouragements do you think he would give to you like he gave to those churches?
- Also like last week, if Jesus were to offer you a challenge, which of the above challenges would he give you today that are perhaps similar to what he gave the churches? Explain.
- How do you handle suffering, trials, or persecution in your life? Do you see them as opportunities for growth, or do they cause you to question or falter in your faith? How can you better support and encourage others who are facing similar challenges?
- How would you describe the current state of your relationship with God? Are you experiencing a vibrant, passionate connection, or do you feel that your faith has become routine or complacent? What specific actions can you take to reignite or deepen your spiritual fervor?

PRAY

Take anything that you reflected on above and spend time praying that to God. Thank him for his promises to those who conquer. Ask for his help to persevere. Talk to him about your doubts, worries, struggles, or strongholds!
